

*General information ICC Trial Competition

1. Visa

The ICC Trial Competition organisation (ICLN) is not responsible for the proper arrangement of visas. Every team has to check for itself whether it requires a visa to enter into The Netherlands. If visa is required, the visa can be applied for at the Dutch consulate or embassy in your country. This application must be done personally. The visa that needs to be requested is a visa for a maximum of 30 days and the costs will be approximately € 60,-. When applying for this visa, you need to fill out an application form and provide this together with a pass photo. It is very important that this is done on time, since an application procedure can sometimes take two months. The only assistance ICLN can provide is sending an official letter of invitation to the Dutch embassy / consulate.

2. Insurance

All students are responsible for their own travel and health insurance. The ICC Trial Competition organisation cannot be held responsible for insufficient travel and/or health insurance.

3. Transport from Schiphol airport to The Hague:

ICLN will not provide transport from Amsterdam airport (Schiphol) to The Hague.

The fastest way (30 minutes) to get from Schiphol to the centre of The Hague is by train (The Hague Central Station / The Hague Hollands Spoor). An one way ticket first class costs €11,90 and second class costs € 7,00 (the fees are however subject to change from the 1st of January 2009). The train from Schiphol to The Hague departs several times per hour.

4. Public Transport in The Hague:
